Topic

This half term our creative curriculum topic is **Space!**Children will be writing fictional pieces of text based on fantasy. Our key text is 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartrum.

DT

This half term the children will be focusing on cooking and nutrition. Children will be learning about where all foods come from and food is farmed, grown or caught. Year 1 will also be learning about healthy diets and will make a fruit salad.

PSHE

Children will be covering the following topics; food safety and what not to eat, water safety and my growing body.

P.E

This term the topic in PE for Year 1 will be athletics and golf. In athletics, children will learn to:

- control their body when throwing, running and jumping
- compete against themselves and others

In golf, children will learn to:

- move with and without a ball towards a target
- hold/ grip a golf ball
- control a ball with a racket/golf club

Music

This term the focus is contemporary music. Children will be learning to find the pulse and rhythm of the song. They will also learn to sing the song, Your Imagination.

Science

Our science topic this half term is plants. The children will be learning to:

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees
- Compare plants, including leaves, seeds, flowers etc.

Maths

This half term Year 1 will continue to cover the following: multiplication and division, fractions and geometry. In maths we expect all children to be able to count and write numbers to 100. Please ensure that your child can form numbers correctly and that they are written the correct way round. It is also important for your child to be able to read and spell numbers up to 20. Please help your child to practise these spellings.

RE

In RE children will be learning about Islam. Our Big Question is 'What does it mean to be a Muslim?'

Our value this half term is **Courage.**

Humanities

History will be our focus this half term. We will be focusing on the lives of significant others, in particular the lives of Neil Armstrong and Dr. Mae Jemison. In Geography, children will explore the wonders of planet Earth using world maps and satellite imagery.
