Year 3 Summer term 1

Topic & History

The term we'll be learning all about the Stone Age. We'll be learning about changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age in comparison to life now. We'll be identifying different periods of history such as the Neolithic, Palaeolithic and Mesolithic. We'll be writing adventure stories Fantasy/historical story based on our key text this term, Stone Age Boy.

GPS wise, we'll be learning about the perfect present tense and how to form it (She **has been** walking for 2 hours now) determiners, continuing to learn about co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions, prepositions, contractions and possessive apostrophes.

RE

Science
