

Topic

Our focus book this half term is Frankenstein by Mary Shelley

Through Frankenstein, the children in year 4 will be learning to write a letter which will focus on being able to write in first person, learning the layout of a letter and how to include the five senses.



This term the P.E. topic for year 4 will be Athletics. The children will be applying a broad range of skills showing control, coordination and consistency when running, throwing and jumping.

Maths

In maths, the children will be learning about decimals. They will expand their knowledge to include tenths and hundredths. Furthermore, they will be learning about money. The different coins and the value they have. Lastly, the children will be learning how to read an analogue clock.



In art the children will be learning to sew. They will be learning a variety of different stitches and understanding how colours can have create a mood or feeling within an image.

Science
