Inclusion Supporting and challenging each other as individuals

We welcome children with special physical needs and aim to ensure our ground-floor classrooms and facilities are fully accessible. Our accessibility plan focuses on making our 18th Century building a better place for everyone.

Extra-Curricular Provision


Education at Christ Church extends before and after normal hours with our after-school care. Our breakfast club starts at 8am, and the teatime club runs until 5.30pm.

At the end of the school day our children are collected from their classrooms. After 3:30pm, for those who wish to take advantage of them, we offer range of learning opportunities with a variety of after-school clubs and childcare provision.

After-school clubs vary each term and provide children with opportunities to develop their skills and interests.
